Diane Sainsbury is an emeritus professor of political science at the University of Stockholm, Sweden. She was also a visiting scholar in Australia, the USA and the United Kingdom. Sainsbury conducts research in the areas of social policy, welfare systems and political participation and analyses gender relations. In addition, she compares the political representation of women in Europe and North America in her research. Sainsbury's publications and research have had a major impact on the development of European gender studies in political science.
